Formerly she held the position of Associate Professor of Entrepreneurial Finance at ESADE Business School in Spain. Her research is published in top academic journals and she has written several books, the most recent being "Entrepreneurial Finance: The Art and Science of Growing Ventures" (Cambridge University Press, 2018), the first European textbook on the topic.

She teaches at the Master of Science, MBA and executive education level in different programs in Barcelona, Madrid, Amsterdam, Milan, Miami, Mexico and Shanghai. She has received the Best Teacher Award 2017, ESADE's Executive Master in Finance and her case "ScytI", regarding exits options for investors, was honored Best Entrepreneurship Case Award by EFMD (2017).
